Information on the processing of Personal Data

Pursuant to EU Regulation no. 679/2016 (*so-called* GDPR), this section provides information on the processing of personal data of those registered for the "*G7 Industry Stakeholder Conference*", to be held in Turin on April 28th 2024 (hereinafter: "**Event**").

Types of Personal Data processed

Within the limits of the purposes and methods defined in this Information, may be processed:

- a) the identification and contact data of those registered for the Event;
- b) the data provided by the data subject to take part in the work of the Event in an interactive manner (e.g. interventions, questions). To this end, Confindustria invites Data subjects not to provide personal data that the GDPR defines as "special", i.e. suitable for revealing racial ethnic origin, political opinions, religious or philosophical beliefs, or trade union membership or personal data concerning health.

Purposes and legal basis for the processing of Personal Data

Personal data is processed for the following purposes:

- a) to manage the request to participate in the Event and carry out the consequent activities of an organizational nature, including the sending of service communications (e.g., logistical communications, possible program changes, useful materials, other notices). This processing is based on the need to comply with and/or to following up with the request for participation in the Event and, therefore, pursuant to and for the purposes of Article. 6 (1) (b) of the GDPR, does not require the consent of the data subject;
- b) to comply with legal obligations, as well as with the provisions issued by the legitimate Authorities. The processing is necessary to comply with the legal obligations to which the Data Controller is subject and, therefore, pursuant to and for the purposes of Article 6 (1) (c) of the GDPR, does not require the consent of the data subject;
- c) to send updates on events and other B7 initiatives. This processing is based on the legitimate interest of the Data Controller to promote activities similar to those in which data subject has participated and, therefore, pursuant to and for the purposes of Article 6, (1) (f) of the GDPR, does not require the consent of the data subject. In any case, the data subject has the right to object, at any time, to the receipt of such communications or to the use of one or more of the contact details provided;
- d) with prior data subject's consent, communicate the data to II Sole 24 Ore S.p.A., so that, as an independent controller, can use them for promotional and commercial purposes and for the direct offer of its products or services. Please note that the data sudject's has the right to withdraw his or her consent at any time. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.

In addition, the Data Controller informs that during the Event photographs and videos may be taken, which may also include participants. Confindustria will use, reproduce, publish and disseminate the photographs and videos for promotion purposes and, in any case, for activities connected to its institutional mission, via any communication system, including but not limited to, the Data Controller's corporate website and social media pages, newspapers, brochures, magazines, newsletters, events, presentations and workshops. The processing is based on the legitimate interest of the Data Controller to promote the Event and B7 and, therefore, does not require the consent of the data subject. Moreover, pursuant to Article 97 of Law No 633/1941, "*The consent of the person portrayed is not required when the reproduction of the image is justified by the reputation or the public office held, (...), for scientific, educational or cultural purposes, or when the reproduction is related to facts, events or ceremonies that are of public interest or held in public"*.

The Data Controller also informs that the Event will be recorded and that Confindustria will use, reproduce, publish and disseminate the recording for promotion purposes and, for activities connected to its institutional mission, via any communication system, including but not limited to, the Data Controller's corporate website and social media pages. By taking the floor during the Event, the data subject expressly consents to the recording, for the uses indicated above, of his/her image, voice, references and statements made during the Event. Please note that the data subject has the right to withdraw his or her consent at any time. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.

The Data Controller informs that the recording of Event, the photographs and the videos will not be used in any way that would adversely affect the personal dignity, honour, reputation and/or decency of the portrayed person.

Nature of the provision of Personal Data

The provision of personal data for the purposes referred to in letters a) and b) above is optional, but necessary for participation in the Event. Any refusal to provide such data will prevent the registration from being carried out.

The provision of personal data for the purposes referred to in letter c) above is not necessary for participation in the Event. However, any objection will not allow the Data Controller to send updates on events and other B7 initiatives.

The provision of personal data for the purposes referred to in letter d) above is not necessary for participation in the Event.

Methods, purpose and duration of the processing of Personal Data

The processing is carried out mainly by means of computerised and telematic procedures.

Personal data are processed by the staff of Confindustria, which acts based on specific instructions provided regarding the purposes and methods of processing.

Personal data may be communicated to: i) external bodies, which carry out support tasks on behalf of Confindustria (e.g. IT services), in their capacity as Data Processors; ii) public entities for the fulfilment of legal obligations, which carry out their respective processing activities as independent data controllers.

For security purposes and in any case related to the organization of the Event, personal data will also be communicated to Unione Industriali Torino, which hosts the Event and who will carry out its processing activities as an independent data controller. Confindustria is not responsible for the use of personal data by the Unione Industriali Torino.

As previously mentioned, for the purposes referred to in the previous letter d), the personal data will be communicated to II Sole 24 Ore S.p.A. which will process the personal data as an independent controller. Confindustria is not responsible for the use by II Sole 24 Ore S.p.A. of the personal data of participants in the Event.

Photographs and video recordings can be published and distributed on the web. In relation to this processing, it should be noted that personal data and images could be extracted from common search engines in the case of online searches carried out by third parties.

Personal data provided for the purposes referred to in letters a) and b) above will be processed for the time strictly necessary for their pursuit and will be stored for a period of 1 (one) year from the date of the Event, except for longer terms established by law.

Without prejudice to the right to object, the personal data provided for the purposes referred to in letter c) above will be processed for no longer than 1 (one) year from the date of the Event.

For personal data disseminated on the web, it is not possible to define an absolute and certain period of retention.

Data subjects' rights

At any time, data subjects have the right to access their personal data, to request correction, updating and deletion. Restriction of processing and data portability may also be requested. Moreover, if the processing is deemed to be carried out in violation of personal data protection legislation, it is recognized the right to lodge a complaint with the Italian Data Protection Authority, Piazza Venezia, 11 - 00187 - Rome.
